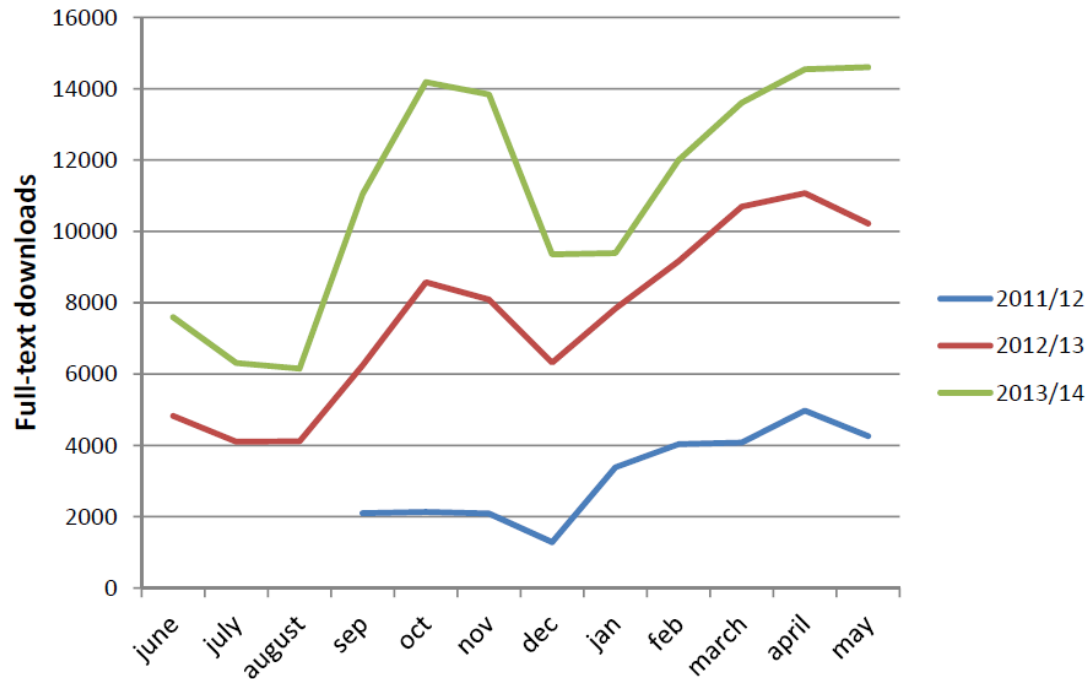


# CPC Report IACCP General Assembly 2014

- *Journal of Cross-Cultural Psychology*
  - Deborah Best took over as editor in July 2012
  - Increment in submissions
    - 339 new submissions in 2013; 174 so far in 2014
  - Impact factor 2012: 1.547
  - Publication backlog increased, SAGE agreed to go to 10 issues per year (1,660 pages); increase in institutional but not individual subscriptions
    - Note: increase in issues may temporarily reduce impact factor
  - Rejection rate: about 80%
  - New contract negotiated with Sage
    - Period: 2014-2024
    - Continue to generate funds for IACCP

- *Online Readings in Psychology and Culture*
  - Currently 103 items on line
  - Number of downloads is large and has increased spectacularly



- Plans

- Discussion on status of ORPC

- Now mainly learning tool, may become more journal-like in the future (reviews of the field that can be used in cross-cultural psychology)

- Revise, update some chapters

- Expand portfolio so as to achieve more systematic coverage of the field

- New publications at IACCP website
  - Summaries of LA conference 2013
  - Proceedings of Stellenbosch meeting 2012
- **Overall conclusion**
  - **New contract with Sage continues to ensure a firm financial basis of IACCP in the coming period**
  - **JCCP is in good shape**
  - **ORPC is in good shape, with some editorial policy changes to come**
