- Resources of the Association are stable
 - Membership increased in 2012 but slightly declined in 2013-2014
 - Total equity at end of FY 2014: \$346,139
 - At last report (FY 2012): \$257,954
 - \$20,578 in CD dedicated for the Pola & Harry Triandis fund

Payment Methods

- Online payments account for 94.7% of all dues paid
 - \$67,077
- Majority pay through YourPay (938 payments) rather than PayPal (57 payments)
